Emergency Resident Station(s) shall be Alpha Communications®/Tektone model IR155N, or approved equal. Model IR155N shall include solid-state call-placed and intercom in-use indicators a 6-foot-long nylon pull cord for call placement, and a 3.50" speaker/microphone with voice response.

The IR155N is mounted on a rugged extruded aluminum faceplate. Positive screw terminals shall be used for electrical connections.

Contractor shall observe all local and national electrical and building codes.

The Alpha Communications® IR155N Emergency Patient Station provides for efficient use of the nursing staff by permitting fast and reliable communication between nurse and resident. Calling the nurse is accomplished by pulling the 6-foot-long nylon pull cord mounted on the station. Call-placed assurance and intercom operation is indicated by reliable solid-state LED indicators. The speaker/microphone is sensitive enough to assure clear conversations even with weak residents. Calls are cancelled (only at the point of origin) by simply returning the reset switch to the 'UP' position.
