## ARCHITECTS' AND ENGINEERS' SPECIFICATIONS

The A.D.A. sign(s) shall be Alpha Communications® model SIPFHBR, or approved equal.

At each remote location, contractor shall furnish and install one (1) model SIPFHBR special Braille sign in addition to the Area of Refuge (Area of Rescue) remote station. Each SIPFHBR sign shall be made of molded Black plastic with .625"H (16mm) raised Silver lettering and raised Braille symbols, with the wording 'PRESS FOR HELP'. Sign(s) shall have a convenient self-stick backing for easy peel and stick installation onto any clean, smooth surface.

Contractor shall observe all local and national electrical and building codes (and A.D.A. regulations).

## SIPFHBR Area of Refuge (Area of Rescue) Special Braille Sign

The Alpha Communications® SIPFHBR special Braille signs are designed to be used with Area of Refuge (a.k.a. Area of Rescue) remote intercom stations, to provide visual and Braille information for people needing rescue assistance.

Each SIPFHBR sign features large .625"H (16mm) raised lettering (in a contrasting color) and raised Braille symbols, with the wording 'PRESS FOR HELP'.

A convenient self-stick backing makes these signs easy to apply to any clean, smooth surface.
